




4. TWC has been in continuous violation of the Arbitrators' Award issued July 2, 2013.
5. Not later than July 26, 2013, TWC shall pay to the Entertainment Industry Foundation ("EIF") the sum of \$400,000 constituting sanctions for TWC's ongoing violations of the July 2, 2013 Arbitrators' Award, from July 4, 2013 through the date of this Award.
6. TWC shall pay to EIF the sum of \$25,000 for each calendar day following the date of this Award that TWC is not in substantial compliance with the terms of this Award, provided, however, that said sum shall increase to \$50,000 for each calendar day after July 26, 2013 that TWC is not in substantial compliance with this Award with respect to all digital advertising materials (including, but not limited to, trailers, internet, TV spots, EPKs) and for each calendar day after August 2, 2013 that TWC is not in substantial compliance with this Award with respect to all print advertising materials (including, but not limited to, one sheets, standees, billboards). For the avoidance of doubt, the maximum daily sanction shall not exceed \$50,000. All such sums shall be paid no later than the initial US theatrical release date of TWC's motion picture. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if TWC is in substantial compliance with this Award on or before the foregoing dates, with regard to both digital and print media, then the monetary sanctions provided for in this paragraph shall end on July 26, 2013.
7. In accordance with Provision 5.4 of the TRB Rules, TWC shall also pay (a) the sum of \$100,000 to EIF no later than July 26, 2013; and (b) verifiable legal fees in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 to Warner Bros., no later than 14 days following TWC's receipt of invoices for such legal fees.
